**Thanksgiving:** We spent \$4,306 on groceries and gift cards for 46 families. Additional families/individuals received gift cards. Thank you to Tom Campion and to Maureen Gruntner and members of the Pool & Yacht Club for their generous donations, again this year, of toys, gift cards and turkeys.

**Christmas:** Some 50 families received both turkeys and gift cards, while many more families and individuals were given gift cards. (I logged the total amount, but not the number of cards given out, but for Thanksgiving and Christmas together, it was easily over 200.) Once again, a big shout-out to Joe Fox and his staff for donating the 352 new bikes and to Joe Fowler for providing the assembly space for this great volunteer event. Thanks also to Paul Weinberg and Scott Brezeniak for overseeing the bike assembly.
